

# Abrahams quits Senate

JLP secretary Bruce Golding has said in a news release that JLP Senator Eric Abrahams has resigned from the Senate effective immediately.

In his letter of resignation to the Governor-General, Mr. Abrahams explained that he had accepted appointment with an inter-governmental organisation which will preclude further service in Parliament at this time, the release said.

Mr. Abrahams, who is a former Director of Tourism, considered himself fortunate that in his new capacity he will be able to continue making a contribution to Jamaica and the rest of the Caribbean area in

the field of tourism development.
