Private Sector Organisation executive director Eric Anthony Abrahams is to be the new JLP candidate for East Portland.

Mr. Abrahams replaces attorney Ian Ramsay who was expelled from the JLP three weeks ago for what the party said was his "indisciplined behaviour" and his "running of the constituency as a private empire."

Mr. Abrahams is a former Director of Tourism. He joined the Jamaica Tourist Board in 1967 as Administrative Assistant to the Tourism Director.

He has been executive director of the PSOJ since the organisation was formed earlier this year.

Mr. Abrahams attended Jamaica College. He studied at the University of the West

Indies and was a Rhodes scholar in 1961.

At Oxford University, he studied Jurisprudence and was president of the Oxford Union Society in 1963.

He was once a producer and reporter with the British Broadcasting Corporation.
