

ERIC A. ABRAHAMS, B.A.

J.L.P. Candidate for Portland East, was born in Kingston on 5th May, 1940. He was educated at Jamaica College and U.W.I. where he won the Rhodes Scholarship. At Oxford University he became the second West Indian to become President of the Oxford Union.

On leaving Oxford, Mr. Abrahams worked as the 'first black T.V. reporter at the B.B.C. before returning to Jamaica to work with the Tourist Board. He later became Director of Tourism and was appointed a Director of Air Jamaica.

Mr. Abrahams has sponsored several community organizations in Portland, and lists his hobbies as Squash, Swimming and Tennis.

Mr. Abrahams, an Anglican, is a family man and the father of two children.
