## UWI's Baugh at UCLA

The following appeared in the May 1980 Newsletter of the Centre for Afro-American Studies (CAAS) of the University of California, Los Angeles, (UCLA). Edward A. C. Baugh, distinguished Professor of English at the University of the West Indies, Mona, served as a Visiting Professor in the UCLA Department of English during the Winter Quarter.

As a specialist in Caribbean Literature, a writer as well as a poet, Professor Baugh was enthusiastically received by the UCLA students, faculty and staff who attended his lectures and his two courses, "The Colonial Experience in Caribbean Literature" (a graduate seminar) and "Caribbean Literature" (an undergraduate offering). In addition to authoring numerous articles and books, including *Critics on Caribbean Literature* (St. Martin's Press), he is also a



member of the Executive Committee of the Association for Commonwealth Literature and Language Studies and editor of the Association's West Indian division journal, *Carib*.
