In 1968 a friend of the Accountant's saw the painting and said it was like one she had seen for sale in New Orleans at Reilly's Gallery for \$ She afterwards obtained a photograph of this water colour which is 11" x 7 3/4 and sent it to Mrs. McGregor. This water colour is signed I. M. Belisario and is entitled "Sugar Works at Kelly's". The detail and view are exactly the same as that of the oil, the only difference being that the water colour has some geese and turkeys in the foreground.
