

PJ appointed Privy Council Member

PRIME Minister P.J. Patterson has been appointed a Member of the Privy Council of Queen Elizabeth II.

A release issued yesterday said that the announcement from Buckingham Palace, London, came through the Governor General, Sir Howard Cooke, at King's House.

"The Queen has been graciously pleased to approve that the Honourable Percival Noel James Patterson, Q.C., M.P., Prime Minister of Jamaica, be appointed a Member of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council," the King's House statement said.

The honour means that the accepted form of address of the Prime Minister as of yesterday will be: The Right Hon. Percival Noel James Patterson, P.C., Q.C., M.P.
