



PJ makes the news in Britain

British newspapers yesterday carried major news stories on the breakdown of the EEC-ACP sugar talks in Brussels.

The papers quoted extensively Foreign Trade Minister P.J. Patterson, one of the principal negotiators at the talks. Both the major television networks, the BBC and ITV, had interviews with the Minister. Local Radio stations also had in-depth interviews with Mr. Patterson.

The Minister will now go on to Dakar, Senegal, where ACP Ministers will meet on December 19 and 20 to review last week's negotiations with the EEC before entering into the final round of talks with the Common Market, possibly in January 1975.
