

'Kapo' now bishop

Mallica 'Kapo' Reynolds, head of the St. Michael Revival Apostolic Terbanacle in Jamaica, has been ordained a bishop of the Mt. Sinai Spirit-

ual Church of God, which has its headquarters on Putnam Avenue in Brooklyn, New York.

His ordination, which resulted from his being the 'patriarch' of the revival movement in Jamaica, came about when he was invited to the Mt. Sinai Church by the wife of its bishop, Mr. Elbert A. Forde in December of 1975. He returned to Jamaica on January 2, 1976, but went back to the United States on February 27, when he was placed among those to be ordained.

He was ordained on March 11, by Bishop Forde, after which he preached at the Trinitarian Church in Brooklyn and many other places. He gave his inaugural service in his new capacity in Jamaica yesterday at the headquarters of his church at 3 Gandhi Road.

Now that he has been ordained bishop of the Mt. Sinai Spiritual Church of God, Kapo states that it's his intention to work between Jamaica and the United States.

Apart from the headquarters, two other branches are in existence. One situated in Jones Town while the other stands at 70 Balcombe Drive, Kingston 11.
