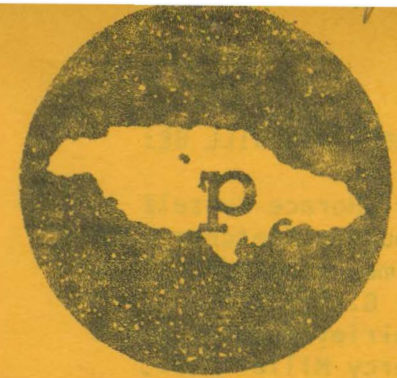
Jamaica Pioneer's Movement is a voluntary non-profit, non-partisan, non-Government Organisation.
