Grenada Senate notes sympathy

ST. GEORGE'S, Grenada,
April 22 (Reuters):

The Senate here observed one minute of silence today following the passage of a resolution expressing sympathy on the death of former Jamaican Prime Minister Sir Donald Sangster.

The resolution was moved by Senate Leader W. R. L. Friday on behalf of the House. He also expressed the Senate's sympathy to Senator J. B. Renwick on his daughter's death.

The Senate was meeting for the first time since Grenada formally achieved Statehood in Association with Britain on March 3.
