
HUGH LAWSON SHEARER

ADIAMAL TO YARARY OF JAWAICA

- MAY 18, 1923: Born in Martha Brae, Trewlany
- 1931-1940: Attended Falmouth Primary School
- 1936-1940: Attended St. Simon's College
- 1941-46: Journalist at the Jamaican Worker Newspaper
- 1953: Island supervisor B.I.T.U
- 1955-59: Member of the House of Representatives
- 1960: Vice president of B.I.T.U
- 1961: Instrumental in the campaign to decide whether Jamaica should remain in the West Indies Federation or seek independence
- 1962-1967: Member of Legislative Council, Deputy Chief of Mission for Jamaica to the United Nations General Assembly



- 1966: Member of Jamaican delegation at the Commonwealth Prime Ministers Conference
- 1967-1993: Member of Parliament, Southern Clarendon
- 1967-1972: Prime Minster of Jamaica
- 1972-1974: Leader of the Opposition
- 1972: Returned to Trade Union Movement
- 1977: President of B.I.T.U
- 1980-89: Minister of Foreign Affairs and Foreign Trade, Industry and Commerce
- 1992: Chairman of the Joint Trade Union Research Development Centre
- 1993: Founder and patron of the Association of Senior Citizens Clubs
- 1994: President, Jamaica Confederation of Trade Unions
