New award in honour of Shearer

THE HUGH Shearer Foundation has announced the first scholarship at the bachelor's level in remembrance of the former Prime Minister, Hugh Lawson Shearer.

The scholarship will be awarded to a primary school teacher from the parish of Trelawny, the birth place of Mr.

Shearer.
