

# Sherlock quits LegCo: Faculty business

**MR. PHILIP SHERLOCK**, acting Principal of the UCWI, has formally resigned from the Legislative Council.

Mr. Sherlock's resignation, sent to the Governor last week, followed his appointment as head of the Trinidad Faculty of the UCWI which will take him into permanent residence in Port-of-Spain as from October next.

Mr. Sherlock is at present in the U.S. and will shortly go on to Britain on UCWI business. As soon as this is concluded, he will go on special study leave which will take him to Europe until September. From there he will go di-

rectly to Port-of-Spain.

Mr. Sherlock was re-appointed to the Legislative Council last August under the new constitutional arrangements which required the Governor to consult the leaders of the political parties represented in the House of Representatives. In his case, his appointment followed consultation with the Premier and PNP Leader, the Hon. Norman Manley.

Consequently, the vacancy left by his resignation will be filled by a nominee of the governing PNP.
