Residences for Heads of Missions

I have the honour to ask the House of Representatives to approve of supplementary expenditure in the amount of £57,142 for the purchase of residences for the Ambassador in Washington and the High Commissioner in Ottawa.

- 2. It had been originally contemplated that residences for Heads of Missions abroad should be rented and provision was made on that basis in the Estimates 1962/63 as approved by the House. As regards the Missions in Washington and Ottawa, however, it has transpired that suitable residences for Heads of Missions are not available on a rental basis: only for sale.
- 3. Two (2) suitable residences for sale have been found at the following prices:-
 - (a) Washington \$110,000 (£39,285)
 - (b) Ottawa \$50,000 (£17,857)
 inclusive of redecoration and refitting.
- 4. The House is accordingly invited to approve of supplementary expenditure in the above amounts for the purchase of the residences required; the expenditure to be charged to a new sub-head "Overseas Missions Buildings and Residences" under Head 6A Ministry of External Affairs (Capital) to be provided in the First Supplementary Estimates 1962/63.
- 5. A Rosolution sooking the approval of the House will be moved by me in due course.
