

Extension of the Rent Restriction Law to Green Island

The Prime Minister on the 21st day of November, 1967, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 4(1) of the Rent Restriction Law, Chapter 341, made the Rent Restriction Green Island Order, copy of which is attached, extending the provisions of the Law to the town of Green Island.

2. Under the provisions of Section 4(1) of the Law this Order requires the approval of the Senate and the House of Representatives in order to be effective, and a Resolution seeking approval of the House of Representatives will accordingly be moved in due course.

THE RENT RESTRICTION LAW, CHAPTER 341

THE RENT RESTRICTION (GREEN ISLAND) ORDER 1967

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by subsection I of section 4 of the Rent Restriction Law, Chapter 341, and all other powers me thereunder enabling, I HUGH LAWSON SHEARER, Prime Minister, at present having the responsibility for the subjects assigned to David Clement Tavares, Minister of Housing, DO HEREBY MAKE the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Rent Restriction (Green Island) Order 1967
2. The provisions of the Rent Restriction Law, Chapter 341, are hereby extended to the area known as Green Island in the Parish of Hanover defined in the Schedule hereto.

S C H E D U L E

"From the South-western corner of Cove at the sea, generally south-easterly along the southern boundary of Cove to the western side of the Main Road leading from Lucea to Green Island; thence in a north-easterly direction along the western boundary of the said Main Road to a point in line with the northern boundary of York Hill; thence in a straight line across the Main Road to the north-western corner of York Hill; thence easterly along the northern boundary of York Hill to the north-western corner of Harding Hall; thence along the northern boundary of Harding Hall for a distance of one thousand three hundred feet; thence southerly in a straight line to the north-western corner of the bridge over the Pell River on the Main Road from Green Island to Prospect; thence south-westerly in a straight line through

Industry to the north-western corner of Prospect
thence south-westerly by a straight line through
Salt Spring to the centre of the Salt Spring
Cross Roads at the junction of the Main Roads
from Green River and Santoy to Green Island;
thence due-west to the western side of the Main
Road; thence south-westerly along the western side
of the Main Road to Santoy to the point where it
crosses the northern boundary of Phoenix; thence
along the northern boundary of Phoenix to the
south eastern corner of Haughton Hall; thence
north-westerly along the boundary line of Haughton
Hall and Phoenix for two thousand feet; thence
northerly by a straight line to the north-western
corner of the Old Fort and Court House by the sea;
thence along the sea coast back to the starting
point."
