MINISTRY PAPER NO. 60

Regrading and Revision of Salaries of Teachers 1967/68

Ministry Paper No. 49 of the 10th of July, 1967, dealing with a regrading and revision of salaries of the Teaching Service with effect from the 1st of July, 1967, was laid on the table of this Honourable House on the 12th of July, 1967.

In Appendix II to that Ministry Paper, the present salary of the post of Superintendent 'B', Approved Schools was stated to be £810-30-900-40-1,100-50-1,250 instead of £870-30-900-40-1,100-50-1,250 and the post of Assistant Superintendent, Mannings Children's Home was omitted from the Appendix.
