- 1. The Company has been granted a licence for 3 years by the Civil Aviation Board, and depreciation of assets, other than furniture and fixtures, is being written off over the period of the licence. Depreciation of furniture and fixtures is being charged at 10% on cost price.
- 2. Included in the current account balance of B.O.A.C. is an amount of £23,273 for communications cost which may not be recoverable.

Included with accrued expenditure are amounts totalling £215,444 payable to associated companies, and accrued revenue includes £238,459 due from associated companies.
